"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2013) and noted that MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification is already recognized with 01(One) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 01(One) to 02(Two) seat(s) granted by Veer Narmad South Gujarat University in respect of students being trained at Government Medical College, Surat be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 with the number of admissions to 02(Two) student(s) per year."

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.



Facilities available at casualty:

For Reception, Examination, Treatment of Medicolegal Emergencies and Poisoning cases:

When any case comes to hospital in emergency, he is guided to attend casualty department where he is received by the doctor on duty & paramedical staff working round the clock in the casualty. Two casualty medical officers remain on duty in the casualty at a time and if the cases are more, then medical officer can also be called immediately who are on duty in different clinical wards to handle the emergency cases. Cases are being registered & examined by medical officer. These cases include medicolegal cases like cases of poisoning, injury, drunkenness, sexual offences and age estimation. They are being examined & report is prepared by casualty medical officers. If they find difficulty in giving opinion, they call Forensic Experts and get opinion from them.

Patient is first treated in the casualty ward & if he/she requires admission in the hospital then after consultation with the respective department in routine hours and on the discretion of medical officer in emergency hours, patient is admitted in the hospital.


