ABOUT US

Government Medical College, Surat was established in the year 1964 with the primary objective of imparting medical education and for extending tertiary level care for the patients of South Gujarat and surrounding regions. Government Medical College is affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University. The campussprawling over an area of 130 acres, now houses the main buildings of Medical College, New Civil Hospital, hostel for students and residential quarters for different categories of staff. At present the college admits 250 students for M.B.B.S. degree course every year. 177 seats of Post-graduate degree - diploma courses are also offered in most of the subjects.

New Civil Hospital, Surat was established before five decades in the year of 1964 with the facility of 300 beds for indoor patients with the primary objective of imparting medical education and for extending tertiary level health care for the patients of South Gujarat and surrounding regions. It was the part of the Government Medical College, Surat which was established in the same year. Gradually, over fifty years, it has grown to the present size and dimensions with teaching-bed capacity of 1150 beds with other 110 beds like beds for ICUs and Special rooms; over and above these.

It caters to the needs of nearly 4000 patients on outdoor basis and on an average 150 to 200 patients are admitted as indoor patients. There are spacious, well ventilated and furnished general wards and special A.C. rooms. Outdoor patient department is well equipped with computerized Registration counters with token system, with separate windows for senior citizens and disabled, stretcher & wheel-chair bay, drinking water & sanitation facilities and broad-speciality and super-speciality consultation services. Hospital has its own round the clock Ambulance services with well-equipped ultramodern Ambulance vehicles and 'ICU on Wheels'. To provide latest Healthcare, Medical Education and Research, Hospital is equipped with most sophisticated, ultramodern and state of the artequipments, instruments & diagnostic services. There are NABL accredited laboratory services for Pathology, Biochemistry and Microbiology and NABH accredited Blood bank in Immuno-histology and Blood Transfusion department. Hospital has its own Nursing college and Physiotherapy College. The ART center of this hospital is awarded the Best ART center in the state serving maximum number of patients with its allied PNC Clinic and STI Clinic.



BODY DONATION

ANATOMY DEPARTMENT, GMC SURAT

The Department of Anatomy, Government Medical College, Surat has been bringing awareness to the common public regarding the importance and benefits of body donation. The department organizes lectures and has been publishing information bulletins and pamphlets time to time. Body donation enthusiasts have already booked their bodies before hand for donating them in case of their deaths. These consent forms are available for such wishers at the Department of Anatomy, GMC, Surat. The entire department is well trained for receiving and embalming the dead body for its preservation and use for teaching purpose.

WHY DONATE BODY?

The importance of body donation is gradually increasing with the increase in number of medical, dental and physiotherapy colleges. For the future to-be doctors and paramedical staff, having the facility to imbibe maximum anatomical knowledge is very vital. This is possible only if there are sufficient dead bodies in the anatomy department of the college. Not only for the 1st year MBBS students but any surgical branch resident doctors need thorough knowledge and practice of anatomical landmarks, surface anatomy and hands on training. Thus, instead of just cremating the dead body as per religious norms, the idea of donating it for the pious purpose, for the betterment of the mankind at large is considered nowadays. Just like eye donation and organ donation, body donation is now looked up to as an alternative for altruism. This is where the anatomy department of Government Medical College, Surat comes in picture.

અને દૂર કોઈ એક જ જગ્યાએ અસંખ્ય કાગડાઓએ ભેગા થઈને કોઈ એક મુદ્દા પર કા,કા, કા કા કા કરી મૂક્યું. સારુ થયું મારું ઘર એ કાગડા-કૉલૉનીમાં નથી, પણ એ સંપીલા અવાજોએ મારી પ્રાકૃતિક વિયારધારાને વિયલિત તો કરી જ હતી. ભલે ને દૂર દૂરથી.

શનિવારે સાંજે દીકરા-વહુની ગેરહાજરીમાં કોઈ કાકાથી અચાનક ટાટા સ્કાય ચાલુ થઈ ગયું હોય અને કૉમૅડી શૉના સંવાદો સંભળાય અને એ વિધુર - વિરહી કાકા અવાજ ઓછો કરવાને બદલે બેબાકળા થઈ ચૅનલ બદલ્યા કરતા હોય એમ આપણને ખબર જ પડી જાય.

બે યાર ઓળખી ન શકાય એવા પક્ષીઓના અવાજમાં, ઓળખી શકાય એવો એક અવાજ હતો: યકલીનો. યકલીનું યીં યીં યીં, મારા માટે યીરપરિચિત!નાના હતા ત્યારે ઘર આંગણાના આ પક્ષીને કૌતુકભરી નજરે નિહાળતા રહેતા. સામાન્ય રીતે સંભળાતો આ ધ્વનિ કદાય કર્ણપ્રિય ન હોય તોય ઘોંઘાટ તરીકે નથી જણાયો. ગણિતના શિક્ષક કનુ જોષીના ક્લાસમાં કનુ સાહેબ જ્યારે પ્રમેય જેવી તર્કબઢ બાબતો ભણાવવાનું શરૂ કરે અને બારીના સળિયા પર બિરાજીત યકલી પટ દઈને ઉડી જાય.






PICASSO - Wall Paintings competition on 28th March 2019

Don't worry if you missed out on the most appreciated event of the day. We are here to brief you about tips and tricks shared by Megha Raoto bring alive the poet in you. So here you go!!

- 1. It is not important to be very poetic and use hi-fi language and jargon to write a good poem. Simple and effective words can do wonders if used well.
- 2. Write your thoughts and ideas. Let your creativity go wild. Choose your MUSE and BE DIFFERENT. She gave the example... to generate curiosity...

I heard the knock on the Door...is too obvious. You have to be different.

I heard the knock on the Coffin... mousetrap... and people are more curious... what next?

- 3. **Be descriptive** and learn to throw in enough details. Make sure you use enough Adjectives to describe any person, place, object or thought to bring out the emotional appeal to the poetry.
- 4. Make judicious **use of Metaphors** A figure of speech in which a word or phrase is applied to an object or action to which it is not literally applicable.

For example, She's poem, divided into stanzas of pain & couplets of beauty.

My house is a calm breeze amidst the thunderstorms of the day.

My principal is a dragon.

Time is money.

And let's see how many adjectives the group could bring out for.... MY HOUSE >>> is...

A Crumbling cake, A Bumble bee hive, A nest to rest, A Creepers' delight, A stashed Book corner, A You can try your imagination too...

5. **Bring out the unexpected** in your work. And Megha Rao gave one line of poetry, which the group tried to finish with their own creativity.

- 6. **Anything can be your MUSE.** Try to write even about the small objects around you. E.g. chair, stethoscope, Mike, coat, Violin, or someone next to you.... Many from the group chose to write on the AMPLIFIER and the PHOTOGRAPHER.
- 7. Lastly, there's no better way to improve your writing skills than **doing profound reading of good literature.** Sometimes collaborative efforts also pay. She also suggested one can write on **HAPPY themes** like Roadtrip, Friendship, Childhood...
- 8. Lastly, it's important that you can **PERFORM your poetry**, in your own unique way, which way you have experienced it, and the way you want it conveyed... That takes your work to the audience.

HAPPY POETRY WRITING. And don't forget to share.
