#### **About Us**

#### **Government Medical College**

Government Medical College, Surat was established in the year 1964 with the primary objective of imparting medical education and for extending tertiary level care for the patients of South Gujarat and surrounding regions. Government Medical College is affiliated to Veer Narmad South Gujarat University. The campussprawling over an area of 130 acres, now houses the main buildings of Medical College, New Civil Hospital, hostel for students and residential quarters for different categories of staff. At present the college admits 250 students for M.B.B.S. degree course every year. College is running PG courses in 22 Broad speciality subjects. Total 177 seats of Postgraduate courses seats are offered in the subjects.

Well experienced & learned faculties cater to the academic needs of UG & PG students of our institute, which is considered best across state of Gujarat. They are supported by efficient administrative and support staff to carry out academic and research activities in the best conducive environment. Institute has well equipped and furnished laboratories & demonstration rooms. Institute has all necessary infrastructure facility with best of the equipments and man power.

New Civil Hospital, Surat was established before five decades in the year of 1964 with the facility of 300 beds for indoor patients with the primary objective of imparting medical education and for extending tertiary level health care for the patients of South Gujarat and surrounding regions. It was the part of the Government Medical College, Surat which was established in the same year. Gradually, over fifty years, it has grown to the present size and dimensions with teaching-bed capacity of 1150 beds with other 110 beds like beds for ICUs and Special rooms; over and above these.

It caters to the needs of nearly 4000 patients on outdoor basis and on an average 150 to 200 patients are admitted as indoor patients. There are spacious, well ventilated and furnished general wards and special A.C. rooms. Outdoor patient department is well equipped with computerized Registration counters with token system, with separate windows for senior citizens and disabled, stretcher & wheel-chair bay, drinking water & sanitation facilities and broad-speciality and super-speciality consultation services. Hospital has its own round the clock Ambulance services with well-equipped ultramodern Ambulance vehicles and 'ICU on Wheels'. To provide latest Healthcare, Medical Education and Research, Hospital is equipped with most sophisticated,

ultramodern and state of the art equipment, instruments & diagnostic services. There are NABL accredited laboratory services for Pathology, Biochemistry and Microbiology and NABH accredited Blood bank in Immuno-histology and Blood Transfusion department. Hospital has its own Nursing college and Physiotherapy College. The ART center of this hospital is awarded the Best ART center in the state serving maximum number of patients with its allied PNC Clinic and STI Clinic.



- 5. **Professional**: who is committed to excellence, is ethical, responsive and accountable to patients, community and profession.





#### **Short Overview of 1stYear MBBS Subject:**

#### **Anatomy:**

Anatomy is the subject concerned with the study of the structure of Human Body. Anatomy is derived from Greek word "Anatome" means "to cut up". Anatomy includes appearance and positions of the various parts, locations & their relationship with other parts of body.

Human Anatomy is broadly studies:

- 1. Gross Anatomy: Study of structure of Human Body.
- 2. Histology: Microscopic structure of various tissues.
- 3. Embryology: Study of development of embryo.

#### **Physiology:**

Physiology term is derived from Latin word "Physiologica" which means "Natural Knowledge". Human physiology is the science that deals with the normal functioning of human body system and its regulation. Various systems including nervous system, muscular system, cardiovascular system, respiratory system, excretory system, endocrine system, gastrointestinal system & reproductive system function in a co-ordinate manner to maintain normal life. Any disturbance in normal physiology leads to disease.

#### **Biochemistry:**

Biochemistry deals with molecules of life. As life is made up of molecules, diseases are also caused by misbehaving molecules. You will study relationship between molecules and disease. You will also learn how drugs and other health strategy can streamline molecules and thereby help in removing pain and diseases. You will learn biochemistry through lectures, practicals, case studies and will have comprehensive help for study including college website and Telegram solve your queries instantaneously.

The department of Biochemistry, Government Medical College, Surat is committed to quality teaching to undergraduate, post graduate medical students as well as Nursing and Physiotherapy students. The department is also doing outreach activity like teaching laboratory medicine to technical staff of PHC, CHC and district hospitals.

The department runs NABL accredited Clinical laboratory to cater needs of patients of New Civil Hospital Surat.

#### **Community Medicine:**

The subject Preventive & Social Medicine (PSM) is the relatively newer discipline conceptualized in the early twentieth century. Even after its conception, it has kept on growing and changed. It started as only preventive medicine which was to be applied to healthy people, customarily by actions affecting large population, with primary objective to disease prevention and health promotion.

Later on a social medicine which emphasizes the strong relationships between medicine and social science, and deals with more of study of epidemiology and medical care of society came on the surface.


#### 5. Hostel



#### **Function of the Institute level Anti-Ragging Committee:**

- •To hold Orientation Programmes for students.
- •To hold Joint sensitization programme and counseling of both freshers and seniors and senior by a Professional counselor
- •To hold Joint Orientation Programmes of freshers and seniors to be addressed by the Principal/Head of Institution and the District Level committee and University.
- Send periodic reports of the action taken report to the District level committee and University.
- •The principal or Head of the Institution shall obtain an undertaking from every employee of the institution including teaching and non-teaching members of staff, contarct labour employed in the premises either for running canteen or as watch and ward staff or for cleaning or maintenance of the building/lawns etc. that he/she would report promptly any case of ragging which comes to his/her notice. A provision shall be made in the service rules for issuing certificates of appreciation to such member of the staff who report ragging which will from a part their service record;
- The college canteens and hostel messes are also places where ragging often takes place. The employers/employees of the canteen/mess shall be given necessary instructions to keep strict vigil and to report the incidents o ragging to the college authorities if any;
- •Each batch of freshers should be divided into small groups and each such group shall be assigned to a member of the staff. Such staff member of the should interact individually with, each member of the group on a daily basis for ascertaining the problems/difficulties if any faced by the fresher in the institution and extending necessary help. By building up report with each member of the group teachers or other members of the staff would be able to infuse confidence in the freshers and make them feel at home so as to enable them to report incident of ragging or bullying. Each group in-charge shall maintain a diary of his/her interaction with the freshers under his/her charge.
- •In the case of freshers admitted of a hostel it shall be the responsibility of the teacher in charge of the group to coordinate with the warden of the hostel and to make surprise visits to the rooms in the hostel where the members of the group lodges.
- Freshers shall be lodged in a separate hostel block, wherever possible and where such facilities are not available, the college/institution shall ensure that senior' access to freshers' accommodation is strictly monitored by wardens, security guards and college staff.
- If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority concerned, the accused student will be given opportunity to explain to explain and if his explanation is not satisfactory the authority would expel him from the institution.
- Any other appropriate steps for prevention of Ragging.


#### **Functions of the Institute level Anti-Ragging squad:**

- As ragging takes place mostly in the hostels after the classes are over in the college. A round the clock vigil against ragging in the hostel premises shall be provided.

I WILL FOSTER the honour and noble traditions of the medical profession;


I WILL GIVE to my teachers, colleagues, and students the respect and gratitude that is their due;

I MAKE THESE PROMISES solemnly, freely, and upon my honour.




