Minutes of meeting

Curriculum Committee and Medical Education Unit meeting was conducted on 29-4-22 at 3.30 pm at Council room adjacent to Dean office .

Attended by all curriculum committee members and MEU members (Attendance attached).

- Agenda:**
1. To UG attendance
 2. Logbook and journal distribution
 3. Implementation of new CBME curriculum for batch 21-22(admitted in Feb 22) as per NMC Circular dated 31-3-2022 (Circular Attached Notification No U.11026/1/2022-UGMEB)
 4. Review of CBME courses of 3 years.

MEU Coordinator welcomed all the members and meeting started with permission of Dean Madam.


- Discussion began with agenda of attendance of students (esp. in clinics) being a matter of concern. Regarding this, various measures were discussed, suggestions invited from all and in accordance, formation of Attendance committee was done, to develop a centralized system of collection of attendance from all phases, to make a common institutional policy for timely display of attendance and appropriate measures to be taken in this regard. Feedback from student representative, present in the meeting was also taken.
- Next on agenda was preparation of final Logbook and Journal (wherever relevant) for UG students and to be mailed by all departments to Dean office mail.
- Then discussion began about the Implementation of new CBME curriculum for batch 21-22(admitted in Feb 22) as per NMC Circular dated 31-3-2022.Guidelines provided in the circular for implementation were briefed and following points were discussed.
 - Family adoption program as recommended by NMC for batch 21-22 should begin from first professional year and planning and implementation for this will be done by Dept of Community Medicine. For feasibility, logistics and finances, a letter to be written to higher authorities in Gandhinagar.
 - Yoga training is recommended to begin in foundation course and then Yoga practice should then begin from 12th June every year and culminate on International Yoga day (21 June). It should be maximum 1 hour daily and practiced by all batches of MBBS.
 - Internal Assessment, as per this circular, if required can be two in each phase and the third IA can be calculated from various unitary and continous tests taken throughout the year. Each phase will decide uniformly on number of assessments as per NMC recommendations.

- Guidelines for Supplementary exams have been given by NMC in Notification No U.11026/1/2022-UGMEB and these shall be communicated to the University by Board of studies.
 - Discussion was also carried out on new guidelines of Foundation course, Self Directed Learning, Electives, duration of vacation for students as per redistribution guidelines by NMC for UG batch 21-22, admitted in Feb 22.
- It was decided that Review of implementation, feedback and analysis of CBME course in all phases will be done, for further improvisation.

MEU coordinator thanked everyone and concluded the meeting.
