The meeting started with welcome address by Dean. She welcomed the new MEU and Curriculum Committee members to the new MEU room in the New Medical College building.

Dr. Arpita Nishal introduced the new MEU & CC members briefly. She thanked everyone for the support during her tenure as MEU Coordinator.

Dean addressed the gathering about the structured approaches of CBME and the changes it has brought in the Medical Education. She gave her best wishes to Dr. Alpna Mathur, Dr. Shivani Jariwala and Dr. Dhwani Desai as new MEU Coordinator and her team. Dr. Alpna Mathur assured on behalf of the team, to work with the best of their abilities towards the responsibilities entrusted upon. She discussed the agenda as per order.

1) Allocation of Electives:

- Two Electives, **Block 1** (pre/para clinical) and **Block 2** (clinical) 14 days each would be allocated as per the prepared merit list at College Council Room, New Building. The allocation schedule would be as follows -
- i. 20th January 3:30 pm onwards: Merit number 1 to 80 (Volunteers Dr. Bhagvati, Dr. Anita Sinha & Dr. Pooja)
- ii. 21st January 9:00 -a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Merit number 81 to 160 (Dr. Naresh, Dr. Shweta & Dr. Swapnil)
- iii. 21st January 11:00 a.m to 1:00 p.m Merit number 161 onwards (Dr. Vivek, Dr. Tanvi and Dr. Punit)
 - Roll number 1 135 will have Block 1 posting and Roll no 136 onwards will have Block 2 posting in first 15 days and vice versa in next 15 days. Clinical posting would continue in morning hours during Block 1.
 - If student is absent due to undue circumstances, authority letter given to friend or guardian shall be considered valid.
 - There won't be any reshuffling of Electives once selected.

2. Electives log book:

Dean advised to print basic instructions regarding Electives in the log book itself. Dr. Arpita Nishal requested that all departments should be ready with the respective time table of Elective posting. It was also decided that the list of Electives offered would be added in the log book.

3. It was unanimously decided that there won't be any provision of remedial for non-attendance during Elective posting. If a 75% attendance criterion during Elective posting (each for Block 1 and Block 2) is not met, then the student won't be eligible for third final exams.

Due to paucity of time, agenda regarding timetable schedule of each phase, commencing from February, was not discussed.

4. There was brain storming discussion about Internal examination marks distribution and Dean urged that uniform policy regarding Internal Assessment pattern across various phases should be framed at the Institute level, in consensus with various HoDs and be submitted to the University.
