Gujarat University is approved by the counses of MBBS degree and various postgraduate degree/diploma courses.

An inspection of the D.C.P. and M.D.(Pathology) examination and physical and other teaching facilities existing at Govt. Medical College, Surat was carried out on behalf of the Council in January, 1988, for recognition of the qualification.

UNIVERSITY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Every candidate seeking admission to diploma or degree in Clinical Pathology must have taken MBBS degree of this University or any other University recognised by this University as equivalent thereto.
- 2. A candidate registered for M.D. may be permitted to simultaneously register for D.C.P.
- Duration of the course is 2 years for Diploma and 3 years for Degree.
- 4. The candidate who has passed the postgraduate diploma in the subject concerned shall be given concession in the duration of the course, subject to the following conditions:
 - in the same subject and should be eligible for admission to the postgraduate degree course under the Faculty of Medicine of South Gujarat University.

- ii) The concession in academic terms mentioned is given to the Postgraduate diploma holder only if he applied for admission to the postgraduate degree course of this University within the period of three years of having passed the said diploma course in the same subject.
- 5. Every candidate presenting himself for M.D. examination shall submit five type written copies of dissertation of about 10,000 words prepared under the directions and guidance and to the satisfaction of his University teachers.

INSTITUTION FACILITIES

Central library has 13,276 books and 101 periodicals and journals. Out of total 261 books and 16 journals are available for the subject of Pathology and Bacteriology departmental library has 100 books. There is one centrelly controlled animal house having adequate number of animals. 22 autopsies had been carried out during the year 1987. Clinical autopsies are inadequate. Some more efforts and interest from the authorities is required to boost up the clinical autopsies. However, the surgical biopsies are quite adequate. The department has maintained museum for gross specimens. There are about 600 mounted specimens. Preservation of wet specimens for teaching purposes was in the old pattern. There is a need for full time museum curator and a technician for the maintencance of the museum.

The department of Pathology has adequate floor space for independent cubicals for staff members and tutors. It has various laboratories with adequate floor space. A separate laboratory for postgraduate students is also made available. The department has a big hall for holding seminars and symposias for postgraduate students. Projection facilities are provided with the department. The department has most of the essential equipments including some modern equipment also. The chemicals and reagents etc. are present in adequate quantities. There appears a gross inadequacy of non teaching staff speciallly the technicians. At the time of inspection there were only 4 technicians available.

TRAINING PROGRAMME

Training programme consists of seminars, journal clubs, symposia, slide discussion and autopsies review for postgraduates. The clinico-pathological conferences are conducted occasionally. This is because of low clinical autopsy rate. Overall teaching methods and programme is satisfa-ctory-

EXAMINATION

The practical examinations of M.D. (Pathology) and DCP were started on 11th January, 1988 at 9.00 a.m. in the department of Pathology.

There was one candidate for M.D. (Pathology) and 2 for diploma in Clinical Pathology.

EXAMINERS

There were 4 examiners for M.D. and 3 for Diploma in Clinical Pathology. Out of the 4 examiners in Pathology, only one was internal and other 3 were external. All the examiners were seniors, with rich experience in their subject. There were 3 examiners for DOD, of the three, 2 were externals.

Exercise for M.D. Examination

The examination was spread over on 2 days. Exercises in Haematology, Clinical Chemistry, in Serology, in Morbid Anatomy, in Histopathology, techniques were given. The candidates were thoroughly assessed at every step of the procedures, A slide session was conducted. Where-in 9 histopathology slides, 2 Cytology slides and 5 Haematology slides were given. Each slide was given 5 minutes time. At the end a thorough discussion was conducted. Grand vivawas conducted for nearly 45 minutes by all the examiners and

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various aspects of the subjects were covered. The candidate was assessed taking overall performance and the result was prepared and submitted to the University.

Exercises for Diploma in Clinical Pathology

Two candidates appeared. There were 3 examiners, 2 external and one internal. The exercises were spead over for 2 days. The exercises included, Haematology, Clinical Chemistry, Clinical Pathology, Basteriology, Serology, Histopathology, techniques and a slide session. At the end a grand viva was conducted. The candidates were assessed on their over all performance. The examinations were conducted quite satisfactorily to keep up the standards.

SUGGESTIONS

- 1. Although there are qualified teachers but there are not much publications from the department side during the last 3 years. This aspect has been pointed out to the Professor and other staff members.
- 2. If possible, M.D. candidates should be made to perform a full autopsy examinations.

CONCLUSION

The department is housed in adequate floor space, has adequate equipments, sufficient surgical material & less autopsy material. The teaching staff is adequate, fully qualified and experienced, interested in teaching. However, publication activity is to be improved. Few more technicians, museum curator and typists are to be posted to the department for its proper running.
